NOTICE OF RACE

EVENT

The 2010 New Zealand Freestyle National Championships will be held from Oct. 1st to Oct.3rd in Auckland, New Zealand.

ORGANISER

The Championships will be organised by the AWA Auckland Windsurf Association, for and on behalf of WNZ Windsurfing New Zealand.

VENUE

The event will be based in Auckland, an exact location still to be confirmed. During October the weather conditions are usually: average wind of 10-20 knots, water temperatures of 12-18°C and air temperature of 16°C.

RULES

The 2009/2012 ISAF Racing Rules of Sailing – Windsurfing Competition Rules (WCR); IFCA Class Rules & Championship Rules;

ADVERTISING

Competitors may be required to carry advertising for the event sponsors - both on their sails, and on a lycra vest - if supplied by the organiser.

- Membership formalities can be completed on site.
- Entries shall be online via the AWA website, or on site, please note only cash accepted.
- Competitors shall provide the following documentation prior to completing registration formalities on site:
 - Original Entry Form (**Form 1**)
 - Proof of Entry Fee payment
